Austin Hotels Where Pets Are Welcome

WHILE AUSTIN HAS LONG BEEN KNOWN AS THE LIVE Music Capital of the World, it's quickly gaining recognition as one of the best cities in America for dogs and dog lovers. Last year, Realtor.com ranked Austin sixth among the top 10 cities for dogs and their owners. Austin's 256 dog-friendly restaurants and the fact that 61 percent of households have a dog helped the city earn a spot on the list. In addition to a multitude of restaurants with pet-friendly porches, Austin boasts hotels that cater to traveling pets and their humans. Here, Austin Pets Directory highlights three that go above and beyond to ensure their canine guests feel right at home.

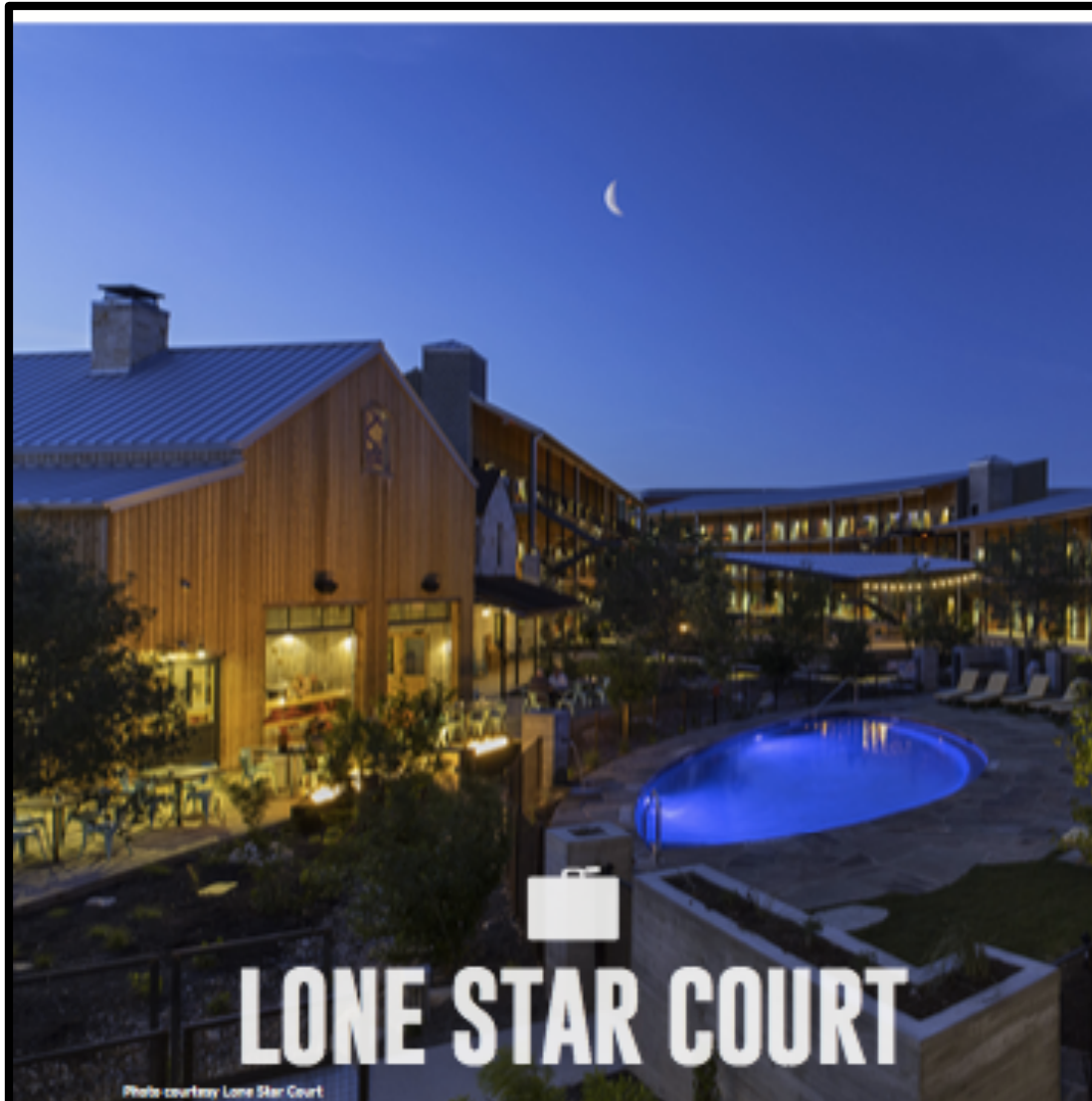

For a boutique “retro-ranch” hotel

experience in one of Austin’s most popular shopping and residential districts, look no further than Lone Star Court. Located at The Domain in North Austin and just a 15-minute drive from downtown (10901 Domain Drive), Lone Star Court has 123 vibrant guest rooms and a chill outdoor courtyard where visitors and their animals can socialize.

Outdoor fire pits, live music, a fitness center and pool reminiscent of a local Texas swimming hole add to the courtyard-style ambiance. For people-food options, guests can have a quick bite at the Feed Store food truck or grab a table at Southern sit-down eatery The Water Trough, which has a bar menu featuring refreshing cocktails.

Lone Star Court charges a \$25 fee per pet and limits each quest to two pets per room at a maximum weight of 50 pounds per pet. General Manager John Thomas says the hotel commonly hosts dogs and cats but has welcomed birds and rabbits.

The hotel’s pet-friendly amenities include treats and a collapsible water bowl. The courtyard area is pet-friendly and offers guests an open place to relax and unwind.

“Lone Star Court provides easy access to the green areas behind the hotel, which are relatively traffic-free. Our courtyard is completely secure should an owner get lost from their pet or should the pet make a mad dash out of a room. We make arrangements with guests to service their rooms at a

time that is convenient with their schedule," Thomas says.

For those who want to do a little shopping, most retailers at The Domain welcome dogs with water bowls and the occasional treat. Additionally, The Domain is home to an abundance of dog-friendly patios, sidewalks and shady benches for taking a breather.

DON'T MISS DOGTOBERFEST

If a trip to Lone Star Court isn't possible this summer, there's plenty to do at The Domain in the fall. The 10th annual Dogtoberfest takes place on Oct. 21. DogtoberTROT, a 1k walk for two-legged and four-legged friends, kicks off the festivities. Dogtoberfest follows the walk and includes a silent auction, canine costume contest, wiener dog races, pet-related demonstrations and more.
